Paddlers

This season has had mixed blessings and with a couple of months of below average weather and trying to put together organised paddling events has been difficult at times.

However, there was a magnificent 'Moonlight Paddle 'at the end of August celebrating the large blue Moon - not to be seen again until 2037 - where will we be then!

A record number of 42 paddlers took to the water and witnessed a great sight, we saw some amazing videos with sound that followed.

Our first attempt earlier in the month may have seen 60 paddlers plus but we were defeated by the weather and the Moon never really showed it's face - nevertheless 30 plus brave members took part and enjoyed some fabulous hot dogs and a buzzing bar before and afterwards. A plus sign, despite the weather, is that we made about £95 which will be directed towards safety equipment for paddlers - e.g. throw lines and safety harnesses.



By the end of September 18 members will have completed the 'Paddle Safer 'courses run by our own expert Ross Macildowie. Added to those who attended courses last year we are seeing about a third of all paddlers now more safety savvy. The course run by Ross is free to members including on the water training and a certificate for attending - it follows the British Canoeing format.

Discussions are underway as to what we do next year - maybe less organised events but more in terms of quality and more inclusive paddling taking Into account tide predictions etc.

NOTE: All rental kayak paddles are now located in the bin store and are locked to the right hand wall. Codes for bin store and kayak paddles, and indeed kayaks are all supplied in the confirmation email sent once payment is processed.

We are moving towards the end of the season now and perhaps some new members - any suggestions are always welcome - and stay safe, follow the guidelines and see you soon.
